Dear Albert C. Wang and MCRD Personnel,

I hope this finds you well! The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the San Diego Half Marathon scheduled for Sunday, 27 March 2022. The half marathon race start is located in front of the San Diego Convention Center on Harbor Drive and the start time is 7:30am.

The San Diego Half Marathon route (attached below) includes parts of Barnett Avenue, Noell St., San Diego Ave, and Washington Street and will be passing through this area on Sunday, 27 March 2022 between the hours of 8:00am-10:40am.

Approximately 5,000 runners will be running their 7th & 8th mile, and passing the MCRD gates, as follows:

- Gates 1 (Barricaded Barnett) & 2 (Barnett): Recommend closure &/or detour to Gate 5 from 8:00am to 10:30am. In addition to the half marathon, we have a new 10K this year that will start near Gate 1 at 8:30am that has about 250 participants.
- Gate 4 (Pac Hwy/Witherby): Continuously able to receive traffic from the I-5 South, Old Town exit. Traffic will also be able to always exit Gate 4 onto Southbound Pac Hwy. For all other scenarios (ie, Gate 4 to I-5N), SDPD will detour traffic to Washington St. from 8:10am - 10:40am.
- Gate 5 (Washington St.): is unaffected by the race.
